i was talking about CSS text-shadow property; but styles were changed a lot in last few month.

it's much better now on 1680 horizontal resolution on 15" LCD. I'm not in position to test on smaller device with higher resolution (like new ipad, ..)

The problem is worth to watch: aliasing is still present, some pixels from oblique lines (letters M,N,A, ...) are still missing, but it's a kind of cute ...
