The main problem is the HTML link, see also issue [#4945](#)

What happens?

You need to click the HTML link to see the content of the file, when doing so the HTML file is downloaded to a TEMP folder on the local computer what results in an incomplete HTML source (no header, body, etc) because the HTML file needs to be opened within the C3 lay-out.

References to the CSS file (for the correct rendering) are not implemented in the HTML file, in the above example: background-image: ... results in a endless repeated background.

My opinion? Fix issue [#4945](#) so HTML (and PDF) files are immediately visible within the C3 layout and all issues are gone.
