<p>When changing the course manager, the newly appointed course manager is NOT automatically registered for the course (if he/she was not registered already).</p> <p>This creates a situation where one is a course manager without having access to the course. One cannot even see the course in one's course list.</p> <p>Workaround: a platform admin needs to register the newly appointed course manager for that course.</p> <p>Kind regards</p> <p>Steven</p> <p>PS: the same term is used for the main course manager and the other course managers (at least it is in the Dutch translation) which might add to the confusion.</p>
