A teacher chooses to subscribe students to groups by him/herself, not free subscription by students. In the settings-screen it is still obligatory to define minimum-maximum users per group while this is useless. When giving values that do not correspond with the amount of users already subscribed to the groups (eg. I subscribed 3-4 users per group, and give in the settings screen as minimum '6' and maximum '8', this only gives a red sign/error without any explanation why. Better should be that if a teacher subscribes users to groups itself, the min-max setting is not obliged to fill in. Minimum there should be a clear explanation to the teacher why the case above (min-max not corresponding with amount of users already in groups) did not work.
