Description

I believe the main/install folder is well protected now, and nothing you could do from the web interface could affect the current portal.

Verify this is true and, if so, remove the alert appearing in the admin section after installation, asking to delete main/install/

However, an alert should still appear if main/inc/configuration.php is still writeable.
